

RESOLUTION 2016-11

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING WORKER'S COMPENSATION COVERAGE TO VOLUNTEERS OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI.

WHEREAS, the City of Garibaldi is a participant in the City-County Insurance Services Worker's Compensation group; and

WHEREAS, the City elects to provide worker's compensation coverage to certain classes of volunteer workers pursuant to ORS 656.031, and setting the assumed wage for worker's compensation coverage for volunteer firefighters at \$2,000.00 per month in the Fiscal Year 2016-2017; and

WHEREAS, the City must also cover political volunteers pursuant to ORS 656.031 including the members of the City Council, Planning Commission, Budget Committee, Urban Renewal Agency, Tourism Commission, and all other committees and sub-committees of the City; and

WHEREAS, said resolution provides for the updating of the above coverage annually by resolution of the City Council,

NOW, THEREFORE THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to ORS 656.031, worker's compensation coverage will be provided to the classes of volunteer workers listed on the Volunteer Election Form that is hereby made part of this Resolution.

Section 2. An assumed wage of TWO-THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) per month will be used for the City's volunteer firefighters.

Section 3. All political committees, boards and commissions of the City, including the City Council, have an assumed wage of TWO-THOUSAND-FIVE-HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500) per year per committee.

Section 4. The City elects not to cover court-mandated community service workers/inmates on work release for worker's compensation benefits.

Section 5. A roster of active volunteers will be kept by City staff for reporting purposes. It is acknowledged that City-County Insurance Service may request copies of these rosters at any time.

Section 6. Unanticipated volunteer projects or exposure not addressed herein will be added onto the City of Garibaldi's coverage agreement by; 1) endorsement; 2) with advance notice to City-County Insurance Services, and; 3) allowing two (2) weeks for processing. It is hereby acknowledged that coverage of this type cannot be backdated.

Section 7. The provisions of this Resolution shall be effective 1 July 2016 for the fiscal year beginning 1 July 2016 and ending 30 June 2017. The worker's compensation coverage for volunteers that is the subject of this Resolution shall be updated annually by Resolution.

RESOLUTION 2016-10

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE CONTINUATION OF FRANCHISE FEES ON THE CITY'S WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITIES IN THE FY 2016-2017 BUDGET.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In FY 2016-2017, the City Treasurer shall continue the practice of assessing the City's water and wastewater utilities an in-lieu-of-franchise fee, of three percent (3%) of earned income, said amounts to be transferred monthly from the Water and Wastewater Funds to the Street Fund.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


