

RESOLUTION 2013-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL APPROVING AN EXEMPTION TO COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENTS OF THE GARIBALDI MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.10, PUBLIC CONTRACTS, TO PURCHASE A PUBLIC SAFETY VEHICLE

WHEREAS, the City of Garibaldi desires to purchase a vehicle for use by its Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the equipment to be purchased has been purchased by the State of Oregon through a cooperative procurement agreement following all competitive purchasing rules under Oregon Revised Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the GMC §3.10.080(E) states that an exemption to the competitive bidding requirements of the City's Public Contracting Rules may be made by the Contract Review Board (City Council) if the City chooses to utilize another governmental agency's purchase agreement, provided that (1) the original contract meets the requirements of the City's code, (2) the City is allowed to use the other agency's purchase agreement and (3) the other agency concurs with the purchase; and

WHEREAS, the City of Garibaldi has an agreement with the State of Oregon that allows for and regulates the use of the State of Oregon Department of Administrative Services (DAS) Cooperative Procurement Agreements;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The recitals of this resolution are incorporated herein by reference and adopted as findings in support of this approval of this exemption. The City Council also finds that the requirements of GMC §3.10.080(E) are met because the original State of Oregon – DAS purchasing contract meets the requirements of the City's code, and the City participates in the state's cooperative purchasing program.


Section 2. The Garibaldi City Council acting as the Garibaldi Contract Review Board hereby approves the use of an alternate contracting method as an exemption to the City's competitive bid requirements, pursuant to GMC §3.09.080(E).

Section 3. The Garibaldi City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to purchase a 2014 Ford Interceptor with all necessary additions and modifications for law enforcement service through existing Oregon DAS contracts. The City Council directs the City Manager to ensure that all purchases comply with the City's public contracting rules, and that total expenses associated with this purchase do not exceed \$40,000.
