

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-07

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING AN OREGON DEPARTMENT OF LAND CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT (DLCD) TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR A BUILDABLE LANDS INVENTORY AND NEEDS ASSESSMENT COMP PLAN UPDATE.

WHEREAS, the Garibaldi City Council has determined that the economic condition of the city's downtown commercial district has been in decay and that a Comprehensive Plan Update may provide direction and answers as to how the City may improve those conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Garibaldi City Council directed staff at their May 16th regular meeting to follow through on the grant application with DLCD for a buildable lands inventory and needs assessment; and

WHEREAS, the Garibaldi City Council created the City Improvement Advisory (Adhoc) Committee on November 21, 2005 to workshop this and other projects; and

WHEREAS, the costs have been determined, the City applied for grant funding and DLCD has offered to pay for the planning through a technical assistance grant; and the expenditure was not, and could not have been, anticipated when the fiscal year 2005-06 budget was prepared and adopted; NOW THEREFORE,

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The sum of \$15,000.00 is hereby recognized as income to the General Fund, as follows:


Section 4. This Resolution shall be in effect from and after its adoption by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
