

**RESOLUTION 2007-02**

**A RESOLUTION REVISING THE AMENDED SEWER DISCOUNT PROGRAM RESOLUTION TO INCORPORATE NEW 2006 INCOME THRESHOLDS.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Garibaldi established the Low-Income Senior Citizen Sewer Discount Program by Resolution 2002-06 on 18 March 2002; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 5 thereof specified income thresholds for eligibility, and specified further that said income thresholds were to be updated annually, as new figures were made available from the State of Oregon; and

**WHEREAS**, income thresholds were last revised by Res. 2006-02 on 17 January 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, revised HUD Very Low (60% of Median) Income levels for Oregon communities were provided by CARE Inc. 29 December 2006; NOW THEREFORE,

**THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Section 5 of Resolution 2002-06 is hereby revised to read as follows:


**“Section 5.** To be eligible for the discount, the adjusted gross income of the household—i.e. all the income of all the persons over 16 years of age living on the premises—must be at or less than 60% of the median household income figures for Tillamook County provided by Community Action Resources Enterprises (CARE) Inc., to wit:

Median income standards shall be updated not less frequently than annually, as revised figures are made available by the State of Oregon. The City Administrator or his or her designee shall obtain from each applicant such proof of household income and other standards described in Sections 4 and 5 hereof as the City Administrator considers reasonable to determine eligibility.”

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall be in effect upon its adoption by the Council.
