

**RESOLUTION 2010-26**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GARIBALDI TO APPLY FOR A TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM GRANT FROM THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS ON HIGHWAY 101, AND EMPOWERING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN THE APPLICATION ON THE CITY'S BEHALF.**

**WHEREAS**, the Oregon Department of Transportation is accepting applications for the Transportation Enhancement Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Garibaldi desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed pedestrian facility and transportation improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has identified improvements on Highway 101, known as Garibaldi Avenue, between 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and 6<sup>th</sup> Street as a high priority in Garibaldi due to poor pedestrian crossing on Hwy 101 and blighted economic conditions exacerbated aging and substandard transportation infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed project will include construction of a new intersection design with curb extensions and new ADA ramps; replacement of existing sidewalk segments that are in poor repair; improvement of pedestrian crosswalk to increase pedestrian visibility and safety, with brick paver-filled spaces to indicate visible changes in pedestrian activity; installation of conduit to facilitate future relocation of overhead utility infrastructure to further enhance the scenic nature of Hwy 101; and installation of decorative street lighting to enhance the scenic nature of Hwy 101.


**WHEREAS**, the City hereby certifies that the matching share of 10.27% will be available in the City's Fiscal Year 2012-2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF GARIBALDI RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


**Section 1.** The City of Garibaldi is hereby authorized to apply for a Transportation Enhancement Grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for pedestrian facility improvements as described in the recitals of this resolution.
