

RESOLUTION 2011-15

A RESOLUTION ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT TO RECEIVE AND EXPEND GRANT FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SEISMICALLY REHABILITATING FIRE DEPARTMENT FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the City of Garibaldi Fire Department facilities located in the City Hall building at 107 6th Street in Garibaldi have been determined to be susceptible to significant damage if subjected to a seismic event; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Emergency Management has been directed by the Oregon Legislature to administer a program intended to structurally rehabilitate critical public facilities throughout the State that have been determined to be susceptible to damage from seismic events; and

WHEREAS, the City of Garibaldi has applied to the Oregon Department of Emergency Management for grant funding to structurally rehabilitate Fire Department facilities to minimize potential damage from a seismic event; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Emergency Management has agreed to grant the City of Garibaldi a sum of \$270,000 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, City staff have reviewed the proposed agreement by the Oregon Department of Emergency Management to have the City of Garibaldi accept and expend these funds; NOW, THEREFORE

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the State of Oregon Emergency Management Grant Agreement identified as Grant No. SRGP11E212 which is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference into this resolution, on behalf of the City of Garibaldi.

Section 2. The Council directs the City Manager of the City of Garibaldi to be the City's representative to the Oregon Department of Emergency Management for the purpose of administering this agreement.

Section 6. The City Manager of the City of Garibaldi shall send a copy of this resolution (as adopted and signed) to the Oregon Department of Emergency Management.

Section 7. This resolution is effective on the date of adoption.
