

ORDINANCE NO. 8 Repealed by Ord No. 21

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE PRESENCE OF CHILDREN UPON THE STREETS OF GARIBALDI AT NIGHT; FIXING THE TIME FOR CURFEW; DEFINING CERTAIN TERMS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

The City of Garibaldi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The word "curfew" as used in this ordinance shall mean the sounding of the city fire siren a single short blast at the times hereinafter specified to designate and giving warning of the time when children shall be off the streets of Garibaldi.

Section 2. That from and after the passage of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any minor child under the age of eighteen (18) years to be or go upon the streets, sidewalks, or alleys of Garibaldi unless attended by a parent or guardian of said child or children during the hours from nighttime between curfew and the hour of 6:00 o'clock a.m. of any day.

Section 3. Curfew shall be sounded and warning thereof given by the sounding of a siren, ringing of a bell, or blowing of a whistle at the hour of 9:30 o'clock p.m. during the months of October, November, December, January, February, and March, and at the hour of 10:00 o'clock p.m. during the months of April, May, June, July, August, and September of each year.

Section 4. That any minor child or children who shall be and go upon any street, sidewalk, or alley within the corporate limits of Garibaldi between the time of curfew and 6:00 o'clock a.m., of the nighttime of any day during the year unaccompanied by a parent or guardian of such child or children, shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed ten dollars (\$10.00) or by imprisonment in the city jail not exceeding five (5) days or by both such fine and imprisonment, and in default of the payment of such fine, by imprisonment in the

city jail at the rate of two dollars (\$2.00) for each day of imprisonment.
