

CITY OF GARIBALDI.

Ordinance No. 13.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE COLLECTION AND HAULING OF GARABAGE IN GARIBALDI, OREGON, WITHOUT A LICENSE; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF GARIBALDI DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful from and after the passage and adoption of this Ordinance, and its approval by the Mayor, for any person, firm or corporation, to collect or haul garabage for others within the corporate limits of Garibaldi, without first having applied for and obtained a license therefor from the City Recorder.

Section 2. The City Recorder shall, upon request of the Common Council, issue a license to any person, firm or corporation, authorizing him to collect and haul garabage within said City for a period not to exceed 12 months upon the payment of the sum of \$10.00 by the applicant for such license; & which said license shall be revocable by the Common Council only if such licensee quits or fails to haul such garabage.

Section 3. No more than one such license shall be issued or remain in effect at the same time.

Section 4. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, & shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50.00 and costs, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period of 1 day for each \$2.00 of such fine.

Section 5. It is hereby declared that existing conditions are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health & safety; and an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage & adoption

by the Common Council and approved by the Mayor of Garibaldi, Oregon.
