

ORDINANCE NO. 37-

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5  
BY ADDING THERETO SECTION 77-A, DEFIN-  
ING LARCENY AND ADOPTING STATUTES OF  
THE STATE OF OREGON WITH REGARD TO  
LARCENY AND RECEIVING STOLEN GOODS.

The City of GARIBALDI does ordain as follows:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF STATE OF OREGON LARCENY STATUTE.

The following enumerated sections of the Statutes of the State of Oregon with regard to larceny and receiving stolen goods, Title 23, Chapter 5 O.C.L.A. as amended by Oregon Laws, 1941 Chapter 371 and Oregon Laws 1945, Chapter 413 together with all amendments which are now or hereafter may be enacted, are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance:

Section 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. Whereas, an emergency exists,

and it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Garibaldi that this ordinance take effect immediately, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
