

*Amendment passed*

ORDINANCE NO. 44

An Ordinance ordering an election for the purpose of submitting to the electors of the City of Garibaldi, Oregon, at a special election to be held on the 12th day of October, 1956, the following proposed amendments to the Charter of the City of Garibaldi, referred to the electors of said city by the Common Council for their Approval or rejection, and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF GARIBALDI DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a special election shall be held in the City of Garibaldi on the 12th day of October, 1956, at which election there shall be submitted to the electors of said city for their approval or rejection, the following proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of Garibaldi, Oregon to-wit:

Proposed by Resolution of the Common Council and referred to the Electors:

CHARTER AMENDMENT

"AN ACT to amend the Charter of the City of Garibaldi, Oregon, by amending Section 8 of Chapter III, and to repeal Section 9 of Chapter III of the said Charter of the City of Garibaldi, Oregon, to provide that the Mayor of the City of Garibaldi, Oregon shall be elected by the Electors of said city. "

THE CITY OF GARIBALDI DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Be it enacted by the Electors of the City of Garibaldi, Oregon.

Section 1. Section 8 of Chapter III of the Charter of the City of Garibaldi, Oregon shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 8 COUNCILMEN The term of office of each Councilman in office when this Charter is adopted shall continue until the beginning of the first odd-numbered year after that time. At the first biennial general election after the Charter is adopted five (5) councilmen shall be elected. Of the five (5) the three (3) receiving the three (3) highest number of votes shall each hold office for four (4)

years and the two (2) receiving the next two (2) highest numbers of votes shall each hold office for two (2) years. At the next biennial general election two (2) councilmen shall be elected to serve for four (4) years and at the succeeding biennial general election three (3) councilmen shall be elected to serve for four (4) years; this sequence and procedure shall be followed at all subsequent elections ELECTING COUNCILMEN UP TO AND INCLUDING THE GENERAL ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 2, 1954; THEREAFTER AND BEGINNING AT THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 1956, TWO (2) COUNCILMEN SHALL BE ELECTED TO SERVE FOR A TERM OF FOUR (4) YEARS AND A MAYOR SHALL BE ELECTED TO SERVE FOR A TERM OF TWO (2) YEARS; THEREAFTER AND AT ALL SUBSEQUENT ELECTIONS THIS SEQUENCE AND PROCEDURE SHALL BE FOLLOWED IN ELECTING COUNCILMEN AND MAYOR; AT ALL ELECTIONS THE CANDIDATE RECEIVING THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE ELECTED.

Section 2. Section 9 of Chapter III of the Charter of the City of Garibaldi is hereby repealed.

Section 3. The City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of said special election in accordance with the provisions of Section 25 of Chapter VI of the Charter of the City of Garibaldi and in accordance with the provisions of Section 23 of Article VI of Ordinance Number 4 of the City of Garibaldi being the Initiative and Referendum Ordinance of the City of Garibaldi.

Section 4. Whereas the existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Garibaldi, Oregon

THEREFORE, an emergency is declared to exist and it is hereby declared to exist and it is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of Garibaldi, that this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

THE FOREGOING ORDINANCE WAS:


Read for the first time in full in open council on 1st October, 1956 at the hour of 8:00 P. M.

Read the second time by title only in open council on 1st October, 1956 at the hour of 8:10 P. M.


