

ORDINANCE NO. 45

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING AND PROHIBITING THE RUNNING OF DOGS AT LARGE IN THE CITY OF GARIBALDI, OREGON, PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES RELATING TO DOGS PRIOR HERETO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF GARIBALDI DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. Hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person owning or having the care or custody or possession of any male or female dog of any age, to suffer or permit the same to run at large within the limits of the City of Garibaldi.
2. To run at large is construed to mean to wander or to stray, not to be within the complete control, including the use of a proper leash, of the owner or person accompanying or being responsible for the same.
3. All dogs running at large and/or not under the control of their owner or person responsible for the same, may be taken into custody by the police force which shall advertise the facts of the taking of said dog or dogs by posting one notice thereof on the bulletin board at the City Hall in Garibaldi, Oregon, for a period of five (5) days after the taking up of said dog and if said dog remains unclaimed after five (5) days have elapsed from the posting of said notice, then said dog shall be disposed of by Garibaldi City, acting through its police force, as said police force shall deem wise, but if said dog so taken into custody shall be claimed by the owner thereof or person responsible therefor, within said time, said police may turn over said dog to said person so claiming same, upon payment to them for the benefit of Garibaldi City, of the sum of \$2.50, and should the said dog be taken up a second time as herein provided, before said dog can be redeemed, a sum of money in an amount not less than \$2.50 nor more than \$15.00, the exact amount to be determined by the City Recorder, shall be paid as hereinbefore provided.
4. Any person found guilty before the City Recorder of any violation of this ordinance, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$2.50, nor more than \$15.00, and provided further than upon failure to pay any fine so levied, said person

shall be confined in the City jail one day for each two dollars of said fine.

5. All ordinances, including ordinance No. 27, relating to dogs either male or female heretofore enacted by the common council of the City of Garibaldi, be and the same are hereby repealed, save and except that all licenses heretofore collected under existing ordinances shall not be refunded.

6. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Garibaldi is involved, therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passing by the Common Council and approval of and by the Mayor.
