ORDINANCE NO. 46

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5 OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI, OREGON, AN ORDINANCE DEFINING AND PUNISHING OF OFFENSES AGAINST THE PUBLIC PEACE, SAFETY, MORAL AND GENERAL WELFARE.

THE CITY OF GARIBALDI DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 Ordinance No. 5 of the City of Garibaldi, Oregon shall be amended by adding thereto Section No. 32-A providing as follows:

Section 32-A It shall be unlawful for any minor to have in his or her possession any intoxicating liquor of any kind, nature or description including malt beverages.

Section 2 EMERGENCY CLAUSE: Whereas the peace, health and the safety of the people of the City of Garibaldi is involved, THEREFORE, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approved of and by the Mayor.
