AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE NAMING OF AVENUES AND STREETS AND THE NUMBERING OF BUILDINGS IN GARIBALDI CITY, OREGON, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE CITY OF GARIBALDI DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There shall be a uniform system of names designating all avenues and all streets in Garibaldi City by designating the avenues commencing with Garibaldi Avenue of Garibaldi City and extending thence northward and by designating the streets commencing with First Street and extending westward.

The presently designated Bishop Street shall be and is hereby named GARIBALDI AVENUE; the presently designated Pine Avenue shall be and is hereby named ACACIA AVENUE; the presently designated Spruce Avenue shall be and is hereby named BIRCH AVENUE; the presently designated Garibaldi Avenue shall be and is hereby named CYPRESS AVENUE; the presently designated Bay Avenue shall be and is hereby named DRIFT WOOD AVENUE; the presently designated Johnson Avenue shall be and is hereby named EVERGREEN AVENUE; the presently designated Homestead Avenue shall be and is hereby named FIR AVENUE; the presently designated Meadow Avenue shall be and is hereby named GINGER AVENUE; the presently designated Hill Avenue shall be and is hereby named HOLLY AVENUE;

The presently designated First Street East shall be and is hereby named FIRST STREET; presently designated Central Street shall be and is hereby named SECOND STREET; the presently designated Large Street and First Street West shall be and hereby are named THIRD STREET; the presently designated Main Street and Second Street West shall be and are hereby named FOURTH STREET; the presently designated Harris Street shall be and is hereby named FIFTH STREET; the presently designated Grant Street shall be and hereby is named SIXTH STREET; The presently designated Lincoln Street and Mooring Basin Road shall be and hereby are named SEVENTH STREET; the presently designated Washington Street shall be and is hereby named EIGHTH STREET; the presently designated Stark Street shall be and is hereby named NINTH STREET; the presently designated Hill Street shall be and is hereby named TENTH STREET; the presently designated Spring Street shall be and is hereby

named ELEVENTH STREET; the next street west of Eleventh Street and extending parallel thereto shall be and is hereby named TWELFTH STREET; the next street west of Twelfth Street and extending parallel thereto shall be and is hereby named THIRTEENTH STREET; the next street west of Thirteenth Street and running parallel thereto shall be and is hereby named FOURTEENTH STREET.

Section 2. There shall be a uniform system of numbering all houses, stores and other buildings, except sheds and outbuildings, erected or to be erected within the city limits, by placing on the door or door frame of the main entrance to said buildings, or as near thereto as practicable, the number assigned thereto, as hereinafter provided, said numbers to be of metal or glass or a combination thereof or plastic or metallic figure, any of which may be used at the option of the owner and so placed as to be readily visible from the street. The figure designating the number shall be artistic and not less than three inches in height.

Section 3. Each property owner is required to purchase, erect and maintain appropriate house numbers, properly placed upon the buildings located on the property of said owner on or before the 31st day of December 1960, and all houses or buildings erected hereafter shall be numbered before being occupied.

Section 4. The base for numbering houses East to West shall be First Street and the base for numbering houses South to North shall be Garibaldi Avenue. The numbering West from First Street and North from Garibaldi Avenue shall be in regular order commencing with 100 and adding not more than 100 numbers per block for each block added in distance from First Street to the West City limits and from Garibaldi Avenue to the North City Limits; there shall be allocated one number to each 50 feet in each block and on the East side of each street the numbers shall be even and on the West side of each street the numbers shall be odd; on the North side of each avenue the numbers shall be even and on the South side of each avenue the numbers shall be odd;

Section 5. The owner of any house or building required by this ordinance to be numbered who shall fail or refuse or neglect to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder be subject to a fine of not less than \$1.00 or more than \$5.00 for each day's

neglect or refusal and shall be punished accordingly and in default of the payment of any such fine shall be imprisoned in the city jail until such fine shall be paid but not to exceed one day's imprisonment for each \$2.00 of such fine.

Section 6. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
