AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 21 BY ADDING
THERE TO A PROHIBITION OF PARENTS FROM ALLOWING MINORS
TO BE IN PUBLIC PLACES DURING CURFEW HOURS AND PROVIDING
PENALTIES

THE CITY OF GARIBALDI DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 21 of the City of Garibaldi shall be amended by adding provisions thereto as follows:

(1) No parent, guardian or person having the care and custody of a minor under the age of eighteen years shall allow such minor to be in, or upon a street, highway, park, alley or other public place in the City of Garibaldi, unaccompanied by said parent, guardian or other person in control of said minor between the hours of 9:30 P.M. and 6:00 A.M., during the months of October, November, December, January, February and March of each year and between the hours of 10:00 o'clock, P.M. and 6:00 A.M. during the months of April, May, June, July, August and September of each year.

(2) Violation of this ordinance by any parent, guardian or person having the care and custody of the minor under the age of eighteen years is a misdemeanor and such parent, guardian or person having the care and custody of a minor under the age of eighteen years shall be prosecuted for such violation as for a misdemeanor as provided in O.R.S. 161.080.

(3) EMERGENCY CLAUSE: Whereas the peace, health and safety of the People of the City of Garibaldi is involved, therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approved by the Mayor.
