

ORDINANCE NO. 58.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LIABILITY OF PARENTS OR PARTIES HAVING LEGAL CUSTODY OF A CHILD UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE, FOR DAMAGES TO REAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY, CAUSED BY INTENTIONAL TORT OF CHILD.

THE CITY OF GARIBALDI DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In addition to, and not in lieu of any other remedies allowed by law, the parent or parents having legal custody of a child eighteen years of age, or younger, shall be liable in an action for damages, not exceeding Two-hundred Dollars (\$200.00), resulting to real or personal property, caused by any tort intentionally committed by such child. The words "intentionally committed" shall be extended to and mean, loss or damage caused by any of said minor due to his or her gross or wanton misconduct.

Section 2. Whereas, the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Garibaldi is involved:

THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Read in open Council the first time by title, and second time in full, on November 12, 1962.

Read the third time in full, and placed on final passage December 10, 1962.

Passed by the Common Council this 10th day of December, 1962.

Approved by the Mayor this 10th day of December, 1962.
