ORDINANCE NO. 62 (62)

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING CHILDREN ON THE STREETS OF GARIBALDI AT NIGHT, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 8, 21 and 57.

The City of Garibaldi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. As used in this ordinance the word 'curfew' shall mean the sounding by authority of the city of a siren, bell, or whistle as an indication of the time beyond which children shall not be on the public thoroughfares of the city until 6:00 a.m. of the following day.

Section 2. Curfew shall be sounded at 9:30 p.m. during the months of October, November, December, January, February, and March and at 10:00 p.m. during the months of April, May, June, July, August, and September.

Section 3. No minor under the age of 18 years shall be upon the public thoroughfares of the city, unless attended by his parent or guardian or other adult authorized to have charge of him, between the time of the sounding of curfew one day and 6:00 a.m. of the following day.

Section 4. Any minor who violates this ordinance shall be punished as provided by the laws and statutes of the State of Oregon pertaining to the prosecution of juveniles.

Section 5. No parent, guardian, or person having charge of a minor under the age of 18 years shall allow the minor to be on any public thoroughfare of the city in violation of this ordinance.

Section 6. Violation of this ordinance by any parent, guardian, or person having charge of a minor shall be punishable in accordance with ORS 161.080.

Section 7. Ordinances No. 8, 21, and 57 are hereby repealed.
