

ORDINANCE NO. ~~53~~ ⁶⁵ (65)

An Ordinance adopting a uniformed building code for the City of Garibaldi, Oregon by adopting the 1964 Revision of the Uniform Building Code recommended by the Bureau of Municipal Research and Service and the League of Oregon Cities and adopted and approved by the office of the Oregon State Fire Marshall, Chief Building Inspector of State of Oregon, Chief Electrical and Safety Inspector, Oregon State Bureau of Labor, National Board Fire Underwriters and National Lumber Manufacturer Association, providing penalties and repealing Ordinance NO. 53.

The City of Garibaldi does ordain as follows:

ARTICLE I.

Section 1. The 1964 Revision of the Uniform Building Code, approved by the Bureau of Municipal research and Service, League of Oregon Cities, the Oregon State Fire Marshall, the Oregon Chief Plumbing Inspector, the Chief Electrical and Safety Inspector, Oregon State Bureau of Labor, International Conference of Building Officials and National Lumber Manufacturer Association, which 1964 Revision is attached to and made a part of this Ordinance, is hereby adopted.

Section 2. Ordinance NO. 53 of the City of Garibaldi is hereby repealed

Section 3. Whereas the peace, health and safety of the people of Garibaldi is involves:

Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force of effect from and after it is passed by the common council and approval of and by the Mayor.
