

ORDINANCE NO. 99

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 61 and ORDINANCE NO. 97 AND PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF OVERNIGHT PARKING ON THE STREETS AND PUBLIC WAYS OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI.

THE CITY OF GARIBALDI DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 61 is amended to read as follows:

Section 66. OVERNIGHT USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

(1) The overnight use of motor vehicles for camping and living purposes is prohibited within the city limits except as provided below. Motor vehicles has the same meaning as provided in State law and further includes any camping trailer, recreational vehicles, or boat parked on a trailer which may be used for overnight sleeping.


(2) The overnight use of motor vehicles is allowed in organized camping and recreational vehicle parks within the city.

(3) The overnight use of motor vehicles is allowed in residential areas so long as the adjacent landowner consents to the parking of the vehicle. In no event shall the motor vehicle be parked longer than seven days without special permission of the City Council.

(4) No motor vehicle shall discharge any waste water or solid waste in the streets, public ways or upon private property except directly into the sanitary sewer.

(5) Violation of this section shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of \$10, if the fine is deposited within 24 hours of the time of citation; \$20, if not paid within 24 hours; and \$30 if a notice is necessary. Each additional one hour constitutes a separate violation. The City Council may designate a higher fine schedule by resolution.
