

GARIBALDI ORDINANCES

ORDINANCE NO. 143

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING ORS CHAPTER 153 (OTHERWISE KNOWN AS INFRACTION PROCEDURES) AND ORS CHAPTERS 801 to 823 (OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE OREGON VEHICLE CODE), REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 51, 61, 97 AND 99 AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES RELATING TO TRAFFIC PROCEDURES AND INFRACTIONS HERETOFORE ADOPTED, RETAINING EXISTING TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS AND MARKINGS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Garibaldi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Procedures The provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes Chapter 153 as presently enacted hereby are adopted as Municipal Court procedure for enforcing all violations of City ordinances which are infractions; provided, however, that the adoption of such a procedure shall not prevent the City from using other procedures to enforce compliance with City ordinances which do not relate to the ownership and operation of vehicles.


Section 2. Offenses The provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes Chapters 801 to 823 as presently enacted hereby are adopted to regulate the ownership and operation of vehicles within the limits of the City of Garibaldi.

Section 3. Existing Signs and Markings All existing traffic signs, signals and markings which direct, control or regulate traffic at the time of the adoption of this ordinance hereby are retained.

Section 4. Repealed Ordinances All ordinances, including Ordinance No. 51 relating to jury trials and Ordinances No. 61, 97 and 99 relating to vehicle offenses previously enacted by the City Council of the City of Garibaldi, hereby are repealed.

Section 5. Emergency Clause Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Garibaldi is involved; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passing by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
