

GARIBALDI ORDINANCES

ORDINANCE NO. 150

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF OVERNIGHT CAMPING, AND/OR PARKING ON THE STREETS AND PUBLIC WAYS OF THE CITY OF GARIBALDI, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Garibaldi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Overnight Use of Motor Vehicles. The overnight use of motor vehicles for camping and living purposes is prohibited within the City limits, except as provided below. Motor vehicles has the same meaning as provided in State law and further includes any camping trailer, recreational vehicles or boat parked on a trailer which may be used for overnight sleeping.

Section 2. Permitted Uses and Requirements.

A. The overnight use of motor vehicles is allowed in organized camping and recreational vehicle parks within the City.

B. The overnight use of motor vehicles is allowed in residential areas so long as the adjacent landowner consents to the parking of the vehicle. In no event shall a motor vehicle be used for overnight camping longer than seven days without special permission of the City Council.


C. No motor vehicle shall discharge any waste water or solid waste in the streets, public ways or upon private property, except directly into a sanitary sewer, specifically designed for such use.

Section 3. Penalty. Violation of this section shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of \$10.00, if the fine is paid within 24 hours of the time of citation; \$20.00 if not paid within 24 hours; and \$30.00 if a notice is necessary. Each additional day constitutes a separate violation. The City Council may designate a higher fine schedule by resolution.

Section 4. Emergency Clause. Whereas the peace, health and safety of the people of Garibaldi are involved, therefore an emergency is deemed to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
