

GARIBALDI ORDINANCES

ORDINANCE NO. 154

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 5 RELATING TO GENERAL OFFENSES AND ORDINANCE NO. 124 RELATING TO DOG CONTROL, PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The city of Garibaldi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following amendments are made to Ordinance No. 5 relating to general offenses and to Ordinance No. 124 relating to dog control:


Subsection A. Any person found guilty of violating any section of Ordinance No. 5 may be punished by a fine of not more than \$250.00 for each offense.

Subsection B. Any person found guilty of violating sections 2 or 3 of Ordinance No. 124 may be punished by a fine of not less than \$10.00 and not more than \$250.00 for each offense. Any sums paid by a person who redeems a dog from impoundment shall be in addition to and not in lieu of any fines authorized by this section.


Section 2. It is unlawful for any person knowingly or intentionally to possess a controlled substance in violation of ORS 475.992(4). Any person found guilty of violating this section may be punished by a fine of not more than \$250.00 for each offense.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the city of Garibaldi is involved, therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passing by the common council and approval by the mayor.
