

GARIBALDI ORDINANCES

ORDINANCE NO. 162

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 68, PERTAINING TO THE STORAGE OF ABOVE GROUND TANKS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF GARIBALDI ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2, paragraphs 2 and 3 are amended to read as follows:

Exception to businesses requiring motor fuel for daily operations: After approval of permit by City Council, and during continued compliance with the following requirements, businesses requiring motor fuel for daily operations may store not more than 999 gallons of motor fuel above ground. This exception does not apply to personal or resale use. The requirements are as follows:

1. Tank to be of sound steel construction.
2. Tank to be placed on concrete slab of adequate thickness, and with spillage retainer at least one foot high surrounding all sides of tank, with provisions escapement of rain water. Said tank shall be protected from physical damage by the construction of a lockable and approved fence.
3. Tank to be properly vented.
4. Tank to be locked, except during refueling.
5. Installation must be of the suction type, with no gravity installation being allowed.
6. A 20 pound ABC dry chemical fire extinguisher or other extinguisher approved by the fire chief shall be installed and clearly marked within ten (10) feet of refueling location.
7. Tank to be marked Flammable UN 1203 proper DOT markings.

Permits may be so granted, except where in the judgement of the City Council and Garibaldi Fire Chief, the use proposed by the applicant or the quantity to be kept would endanger the safety of life and/or property. The Garibaldi Fire Chief is hereby charged with the enforcement of this ordinance.

Section 2. The City of Garibaldi deems an emergency to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
