

GARIBALDI ORDINANCES

ORDINANCE NO. 166

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 155 TO PROHIBIT THE CONSUMPTION OF LIQUOR UPON PUBLIC STREETS, SIDEWALKS OR PARKING AREAS WITHIN THE CITY OF GARIBALDI; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


THE CITY OF GARIBALDI, OREGON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment of Ordinance No. 155. Ordinance No. 155 relating to general offenses is amended as follows:


"Section 5-A. Public Consumption of Liquor. No person shall consume any intoxicating liquor upon a public street, sidewalk or parking area, except as otherwise licensed by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission."

Section 2. Declaration of Emergency. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Garibaldi is involved, the City Council deems an emergency to exist, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately.
