

GARIBALDI ORDINANCES

ORDINANCE NO. 233

AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING THE CREATION OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL OF TILLAMOOK COUNTY AND ENTERING INTO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT.

SECTION 1. APPROVAL. The City of Garibaldi has approved an intergovernmental agreement attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference, pursuant to ORS 190.010, with the municipalities and public agencies listed in the attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. AGREEMENT PURPOSE. The purpose of the intergovernmental agreement shall be to create an intergovernmental entity known as the Economic Development Council of Tillamook County, to facilitate matters related to economic development in Tillamook County.

SECTION 3. ENTITY DESCRIPTION. The Economic Development Council shall provide coordination of efforts, including business development, recruitment and expansion, distribution of funds made available for economic development activities by regional, state and federal agencies and/or programs.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this ordinance, including Exhibit "A", are severable. If any provision of this ordinance is determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be considered a separate, distinct and independent provision and the decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 5. FEE. The City of Garibaldi enters into the intergovernmental agreement with Economic Development Council of Tillamook County without making cash contribution.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect on the 30th day following adoption by the City Council of the City of Garibaldi.
