THE CITY OF GARIBALDI ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. REPEAL OF PENALTY CLAUSES IN OTHER CITY ORDINANCES:

The following penalty clauses in City ordinances are hereby repealed:

- A. Section 6 of Ordinance 76, dealing with the obstruction of streets;
- B. Subsection 5 of Section 3 of Ordinance 184, the Garibaldi Water Ordinance;
- C. Section 802 of Ordinance 24, the Garibaldi Sewer Ordinance;
- D. Section 9 of Ordinance 145, dealing with nuisances;
- E. Section 33 of Ordinance 155, the General Offenses Ordinance;
- F. Section 2 of Ordinance 208, dealing with jake brakes;
- G. Section 9 of Ordinance 124, dealing with dogs at large;
- H. Section 2 of Ordinance 231, prohibiting the feeding of raccoons;
- I. Section 5 of Ordinance 218, the Garibaldi Curfew Ordinance;
- J. Section 3 of Ordinance 150, the Overnight Camping Ordinance;
- K. Section 13 of Ordinance 22, the Fire Prevention Ordinance;
- L. Section 3 of Ordinance 42, dealing with the burning of rubbish;
- M. Section 13 of Ordinance 89, the Fire Prevention Code;
- N. Section 15 of Ordinance 198, dealing with social gaming;
- O. Section 12 of Ordinance 131, dealing with solicitors, hawkers and peddlers;
- P. Section 9 of Ordinance 16, dealing with amusement devices;


- Q. Section 9 of Ordinance 77, the Business License Ordinance;
- R. Section 7 of Ordinance 15, the Taxicab Licensing Ordinance;
- S. Section 18 of Ordinance 174, the Transient Room Tax Ordinance;
- T. Section 2 of Ordinance 40, dealing with dangerous buildings;
- U. Section 4 of Ordinance 236, dealing with house numbering;
- V. Section 12.010 of Ordinance 107, the Garibaldi Zoning Ordinance; and
- W. Section 55 of Ordinance 215, the Garibaldi Subdivision and Land Partitioning Ordinance.

Section 2. ESTABLISHING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF CITY ORDINANCES: Violations of City ordinances shall be cited and prosecuted as violations, as the term is defined in Oregon law, and shall be punishable upon conviction by a fine not to exceed FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00). Each day a violation continues shall be treated as a separate offense.

Section 3. ALTERNATIVE REMEDIES: In addition to the penalty set forth in Section 2., above, the City shall have as alternative remedies for any violation of its ordinances the right to bring suit to enjoin, to abate, for mandamus, or to bring other appropriate proceedings to enforce compliance with its ordinances.


Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect THIRTY (30) DAYS following its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor
