DOMESTIC CATS, AND LIMITING THE NUMBER OF CATS WHICH
MAY BE HARBORED AT A GIVEN PREMISES.

THE CITY OF GARIBALDI ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. DEFINITIONS: As used in this Ordinance, the term “cat owner” shall mean any person, firm or corporation owning, keeping or harboring a cat. In the case of a residence, the head of household shall be deemed to be the owner and responsible for any cat or cats kept on the premises. The owner or manager of a business shall be responsible for any cat or cats kept on the premises, and shall be considered to be the cat owner.

Section 2. LIMITING THE NUMBER OF CATS: No cat owner shall keep more than five (5) cats on any lot or premises within the City, unless the cats are under four (4) months of age and are offspring of a resident female cat.

Section 3. PROHIBITION ON FEEDING OF DOMESTIC CATS: No person shall intentionally feed feral domestic cats on either public or private property.


Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect THIRTY (30) DAYS after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
