AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE GARIBALDI ZONING
ORDINANCE TO RE-DEFINE "FENCES" AND ELIMINATE
THE CLASSIFICATION OF HEDGES AS FENCES.

THE CITY OF GARIBALDI ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. DEFINITION OF "FENCES" AMENDED: "Fences" in Section 1.030 of the Garibaldi Zoning Ordinance (Ord. 107, as amended) is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Fence. A barrier consisting of wood, metal or masonry placed or constructed for the purpose of obstructing movement or vision, or to enclose an open area."

Section 2. FENCE REQUIREMENTS AMENDED: Section 4.070 (Fence Requirements) of the Garibaldi Zoning Ordinance (Ord. 107, as amended) is amended by eliminating subsection 5. thereof and adding a new subsection 5. to read as follows:

"5. The maximum height of a fence shall be six feet (6') for residential uses, eight feet (8') for commercial, industrial or municipal uses, provided that the maximum height for a fence on commercial, industrial or municipal property shall be six feet (6') where abutting residential property."


Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect THIRTY (30) DAYS after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
