ORDINANCE NO. 266

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE
REGULATIONS IN THE GARIBALDI WATER ORDINANCE.

Section 1. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE REGULATIONS AMENDED:

Section 3 (Discontinuance of Service) of the Garibaldi Water Ordinance (Ord. 1`84, as amended) is hereby amended by adding the following new subsections following subsection 3, as follows:

"4. SEWER CHARGES AND FINANCE CONTINUE FOR 12 MONTHS AFTER SHUTOFF OF WATER SERVICE: When the water service is shut off to a particular premises, whether for non-payment or at the customer's request, the premises shall continue to be assessed a monthly charge for sewer service, and any unpaid amounts shall be assessed a finance charge pursuant to this Ordinance, until 12 months have elapsed since shutoff of the water service. Once the water service to a particular premises has been shut off for more than 12 consecutive months, the sewer charge shall cease to be assessed, and the finance charge shall cease to be assessed, and the reconnection fee shall be computed pursuant to subsection 5., below.

"5. RESTORATION FEE AS A PERCENTAGE OF WATER AND SEWER CHARGES: When the water service to a particular premises has been shut off for more than 12 consecutive months, the reconnection fee shall be computed as a percentage of water and sewer service charges, as follows:

- The fee shall be 85% of the charges for water and sewer service at minimum rate for the particular class of customer and size of meter at the time of computation, multiplied by the number of months service has been disconnected.

The fee in subsection 4 shall apply only if the outstanding balance owing for City utilities at the premises is less than the fee in subsection 4. If the outstanding balance is greater than the fee in subsection 4, the outstanding balance shall be paid instead.


"6. TURN-ON FEE PAYABLE IN ADDITION TO RECONNECTION FEE: In addition to the fee in subsection 4, a turn-on fee, the amount of which shall be set by

resolution, shall be assessed for restoring the service. Both the turn-on fee and the fee in subsection 4, as applicable, shall be paid in full before service is restored."

Section 2. RE-NUMBERING: Subsections 4 and 5 of Section 3. of Ord. 184 are hereby re-numbered subsections 7 and 8, respectively.


Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days following its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
