ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE BUILDING DEBRIS AND INOPERABLE
VEHICLES.

THE CITY OF GARIBALDI ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. ENUMERATED NUISANCES AMENDED: Section 2 of Ord. 145 (enacted 2/23/87) is hereby amended by adding two new subsections, as follows:

- “P. Any remains of something broken down, destroyed or unusable including, but not limited to: scrap metal, scrap paper, scrap plastic or scrap wood; pieces of asphalt, concrete, lumber or other unused building supplies and waste; yard clippings or cuttings of plant material; broken empty glass, plastic or metal containers; or broken furniture.”
- “Q. Any inoperable motor vehicle, trailer, boat in which a major component is defective or removed for more than thirty (30) days; any motor vehicle, trailer, boat which has been unlicensed for more than thirty (30) consecutive days; a defective motor vehicle, trailer, or boat part, an abandoned automobile, used tire, inoperable and defective machinery, or any part thereof.”

Re-numbering the final subsection of Section 2 as “R.”

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect THIRTY (30) DAYS after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
